Supplies:

• Stamp Set: Amber Autumn

• Punch: 2" Circle

• Die Set: Amber Autumn, Season of Circles (Paper Pumpkin)

• Inks: Early Espresso

• Basic Beige Card Stock: 5-1/2" x 8-1/2"

• Basic White Card Stock: scrap for greeting

• Early Espresso & Cajun Craze Card Stock: Scraps for leaves

• Gold Foil Paper: Scrap for circle die cut

• Designer Paper: Gathering Together - 2" x 5-1/2", (2) 1/4" x 5-1/2" strips, 2-3/8" x 6" (envelope flap)

Cajun Craze & Gold Dots, Linen Thread, Stampin' Dimensionals, Multipurpose Liquid Glue, Mini Glue
Dot

Instructions:

- 1. Score & burnish Card Base @ 4-1/4"
- 2. Adhere 2" designer paper strip to card front approxiamately in the middle
- 3. Adhere 1/4" strips to each side of the 2" designer paper
- 4. Die cut Gold Foil Circle and leaves from Early Espresso & Cajun Craze Card Stock scraps
- 5. Stamp greeting on Basic White Card Stock scrap, punch out with 2" Circle Punch with words to the top of the circle, adhere to Gold Foil circle
- 6. Adhere leaves under the words on the circle, adhere to card front with Dimensionals
- 7. Tie a double bow with 16" of Linen Thread, adhere to card front with Mini Glue Dot
- 8. Embellish with Cajun Craze & Gold Dots
- 9. Adhere remaining designer paper to envelope flap, trim off excess
